BACKGROUND

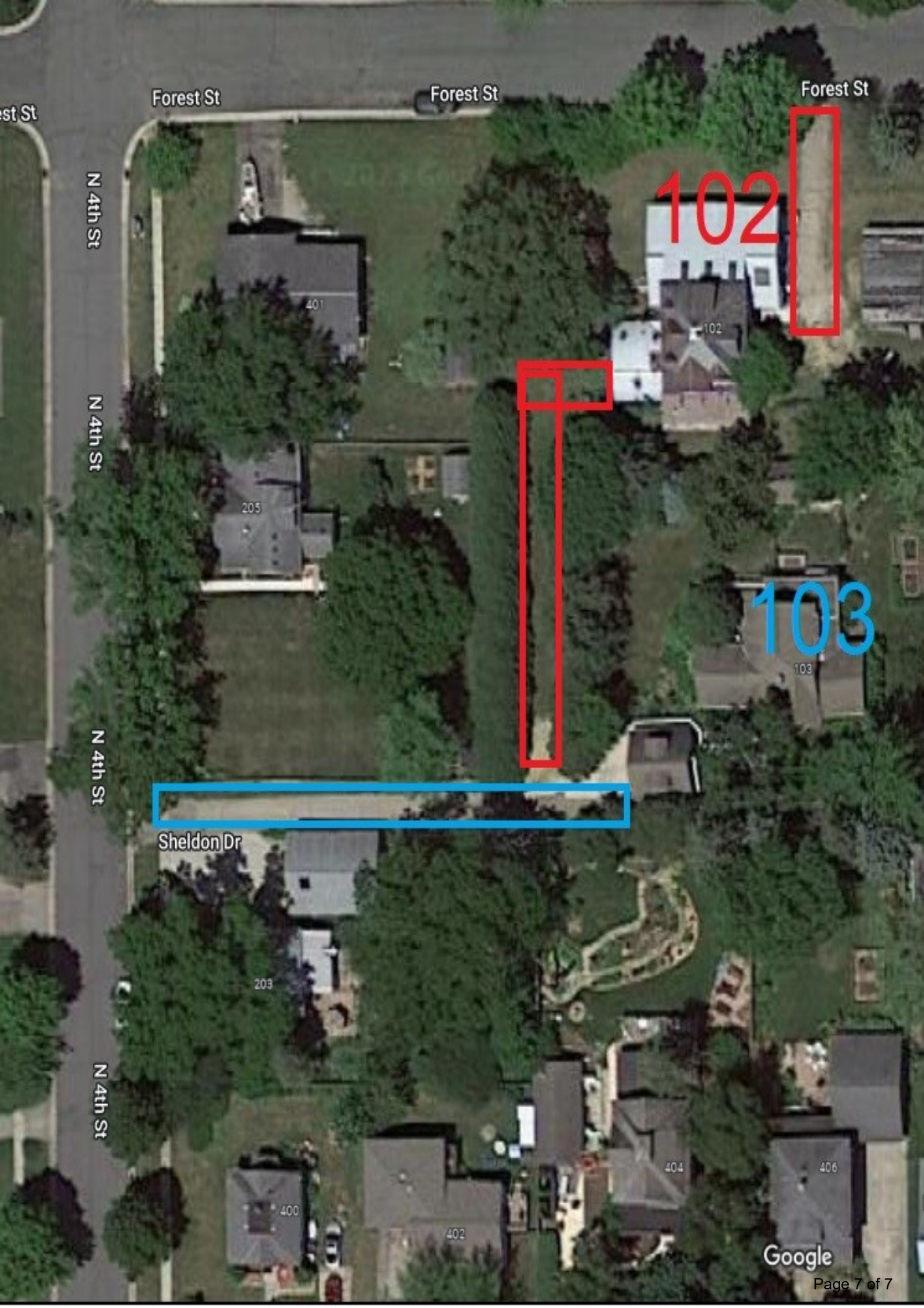
