MINUTES

PARKS, RECREATION AND FORESTRY COMMISSION

January 28, 2025, 5:30 PM, Municipal Building Board Room

PRESENT: Halverson, Adler, Honore, White, Hogseth, Webber, Mertz.

ABSENT: None

OTHERS PRESENT: Owen, Dudley, Gorman – Village of Mount Horeb

Consider minutes of the December 10, 2024 meeting.

Webber moved; White seconded to approve the minutes of the December 10, 2024 meeting. Motion carried.

Discuss storage needs with the Summer Frolic Committee

Dave Reed and Amy Mertz, from the Summer Frolic Committee, were present to discuss the possibility of a storage facility at Grundahl Park to meet the storage needs of the Summer Frolic and aid with set up and tear down for the Frolic. The Committee is looking to have approximately 600 square feet of storage and discussed building a stand-alone structure or adding on to one of the existing park shelters. Several options were discussed. Owen suggested looking at this at a staff level with the Summer Frolic Committee. Reed said he can come up with some plans on what a storage facility would look like.

Consider playground options for Grundahl Park

Gorman reviewed two playground options that Gerber Leisure Products submitted for review to replace the old equipment at Grundahl Park. The location would be in basically the same location as the existing playground but would be shifted south a little to accommodate a full court basketball court in the future. There was a lot of discussion and questions regarding the two options. The Commission agreed to ask the Gerber rep to attend the next meeting to answer questions and provide more information.

Discuss and consider 2025 proposed Aquatic Center dates and hours of operation

Dudley provided the Recreation Department's proposed dates and hours for the 2025 aquatic center season. The pool would open to the public on June 11, which is four days later than 2024. This is due to school being out later in 2025. White moved, Honore seconded to approve the 2025 aquatic center dates and hours of operation. Motion carried.

Update on Grundahl Park ball diamond light project

Gorman said that he is working with Musco on the project. It is the same company that recently installed the lights at the varsity softball field. Gorman said he received a firm quote from Musco for \$182,500 and the Mount Horeb Utilities has agreed to do the electrical work for \$4000-\$8000. The MH Utilities and the Public Services Dept. will work together on the removal of the old poles and fixtures.

Update on the Lukken property

Owen stated that he had received four proposals for the park planning. He is going to put a committee together to review and evaluate the proposals.

Update on AED purchases

Owen said the AED's were delivered to the Municipal Building today.

Update on the ice-skating rink

Gorman said his staff started working on the rink January 6 and it was open for skating on January 15. It has been well-used when the weather has been nice and he and Dudley have not heard any complaints about having the warming house open with no staff.

Review 2025 capital projects and purchases

Gorman provided a handout showing the current progress of the 2025 capital purchases and projects.

Review and consider updating the youth soccer participation fee

Gorman reviewed the participation fee which has been in place since 2012. The fee is \$5/player per season which is fall/spring. The soccer club pays the fee which brings in about \$1500 annually to the Village to be used for such things as fertilizer, grass seed, irrigation and soccer equipment. Halverson liked the idea of keeping the fees low. Honore suggested raising them to \$10/player. Adler does not like the idea of these fees and said if the soccer club did not exist, the players would be playing under the Recreation Department. Webber suggested a compromise by keeping the fee at \$5. The Commission agreed to look at the fees again later this year and compare what other clubs are paying as well, such as the youth baseball club.

Recreation Director's Report

Dudley reviewed her written report.

Public Services Director's Report

Gorman reviewed his written report. The Commission also agreed it would be nice to have a ribbon cutting once the AED's are installed at the parks to make residents aware that they are available. Honore and Owen will work on ordering the AED cabinets and staff will install them as soon as possible.

Public Services Director's Report

- We have hired Kevin Krantz to fill our vacant Public Services Crewperson position. Kevin is currently a Maintenance Tech 3 at UW-Madison and spent 27 years as a Superintendent for Joe Daniels Construction. Kevin will start March 3.
- As I stated before, Brian Haag will be retiring April 1 after 38 years working for the Village. We are currently recruiting to fill his position, Public Services-Parks Maintenance.
- Musco has stated that the new lights at Grundahl Park are scheduled to be installed in early April. Our crew has removed all of the old light fixtures and we will be working with the Mt Horeb Utilities to remove the old wood poles. Underground electric will be installed by the Mt Horeb Utilities once the new poles are set.
- As of February 25, the ice-skating rink has been open a total of 35 days.
- I have ordered a 10'x16' backboard (bangboard) for the tennis/pickleball courts. MOHOP will be funding the purchase. They received a Community Foundation Grant of \$3000 and will be paying the difference of the \$5720 total cost. Our department will perform the installation.
- MOHOP has asked the school district about the possibility of having a drinking fountain on the outside of the middle school, near the courts.
