

**VILLAGE OF MOUNT HOREB
VILLAGE BOARD MEETING MINUTES
APRIL 1, 2026**

The Village Board met in regular session in-person on the above date in the 2nd Floor Board Room of the Municipal Building, 138 E Main Street.

Call to Order/Roll Call: Village President Ryan Czyzewski called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Present were Trustees White, Jones, Schellpfeffer, Gauger, Fendrick, and Best. Also present were Interim Administrator Jon Hochkammer, Village Clerk Alyssa Gaffney, and Youth-In-Government student Aaron Fendrick.

Public Comments on Non-Agenda Items: None

Consent Agenda: Fendrick requested the March 4, 2026 meeting minutes and Ordinance 2026-04 be pulled from the Consent Agenda. White moved, Best seconded to approve the remaining consent agenda items: February 19, 2026 Special Village Board and Finance & Personnel Committee Meeting minutes; February 23, 2026 Special Village Board and Finance & Personnel Committee Meeting minutes (1); February 23, 2026 Special Village Board and Finance & Personnel Committee Meeting minutes (2); February 25, 2026 Special Village Board and Finance & Personnel Committee Meeting minutes; Certified Survey Map Land Division Town of Vermont- Sherven; Ordinance 2026-05, "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 18 LAND DIVISION REGULATIONS, MOUNT HOREB, WISCONSIN"; Resolution 2026-07, "APPROVAL OF CHANGES TO THE MOUNT HOREB URBAN AREA FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM". Motion carried by unanimous voice vote. Fendrick had requested the March 4th minutes be pulled because he was not present at that meeting. Jones moved, White seconded to approve the March 4, 2026 Meeting minutes. All voted aye, with the exception of Fendrick, who abstained. Motion carried. Fendrick inquired about who enforces the provisions of Ordinance 2026-04 and voiced his concerns. Jones moved, Fendrick seconded to approve Ordinance 2026-04, "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 11.09 COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE AND CREATE SECTION 11.10 COLLECTION OF AND DISPOSAL OF RECYCLABLES". Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Introduction of Interim Village Administrator Jon Hochkammer: Hochkammer introduced himself and gave some information on his background.

Presentation of Library Annual Report: Library Director Jessica Gretzinger presented her annual report.

Proclamation for Recognizing National Library Week: Czyzewski read the proclamation aloud.

Authorization to Bid 2026 Street Improvement Project: Hochkammer explained this item. Fendrick moved, Best seconded to approve the authorization to bid. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Consideration of 15-minute parking stall along the west side of S. Grove Street: Hochkammer explained this item, and the board discussed. Schellpfeffer moved, Jones seconded to approve the parking stall. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Consideration of 10-minute take out parking in front of the building on the west side of S. First Street: Hochkammer explained this item, and the board discussed. Jones moved, White seconded to approve the parking stall. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Arbor Day Proclamation: Czyzewski read the proclamation aloud.

Committee reports: All committee reports were given, with no action taken.

Village President's report: Czyzewski gave his report, which was also included in the meeting packet.

Village Administrator's report: Hochkammer spoke about meeting with staff, and his time with the Village thus far, as he started with the Village on March 23rd.

Village Clerk's report: Gaffney presented information on the upcoming April 7th Spring Election.

Adjournment: With no further business before the board, Fendrick moved, Jones seconded to adjourn @ 8:33pm. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.
